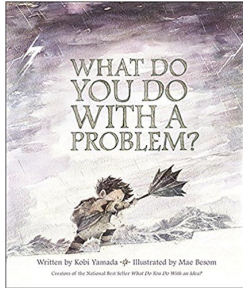


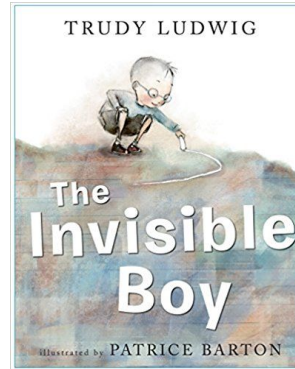
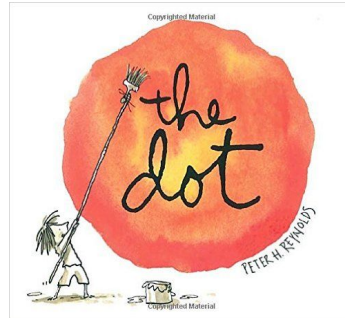
From the Kodo Classroom
