

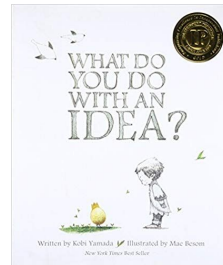

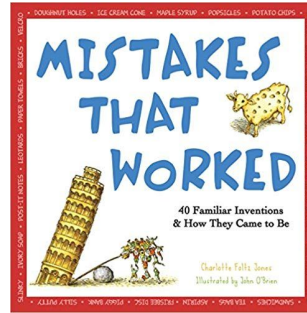
Simple Machines
