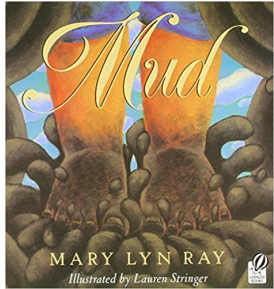


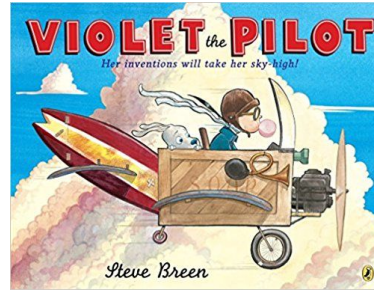
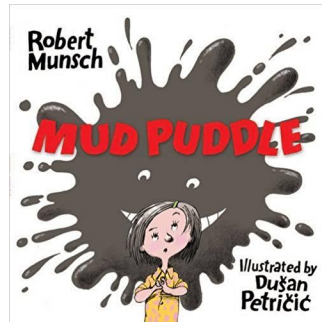
# From the Kodo Classroom
